5 Spiritual Strategies to Block Out Distractions

1. Start with a Burden, Not a Brand

Nehemiah told his distractors, "I cannot come down." Protect your attention like a builder guards a wall. Every 'yes' costs you something. **Treat your time as sacred, not scattered.**

4. Build With Others Who Carry Your Fire

Nehemiah built in teams. You are not called to build the Kingdom alone. Partner with those who share your spiritual hunger and your practical vision. **Focus thrives in unity.**

5. Fight While You Build

One hand held a tool, the other a weapon. Distraction is often a form of spiritual warfare. Guard your heart with **prayer**, **fasting**, **and Scripture**. Stay spiritually sharp. Build and battle together.
